### What not to bring?

Electronics – video games, radios, CD players, cell phones, etc.

Camouflage clothes

Sheath knives or survival type knives

Fire crackers

### Arrival – July 12<sup>th</sup> 12:00pm

Scouts, in class A uniforms, and parents arrive at camp.  
Travel time from Brookfield ~1hr 10 min.

Have medications ready to hand over to Troop Leader who will submit to the Health Officer (see med notes below)

Sunday afternoon Scouts will setup camp, listen to an orientation, and take a swim test if required. Most scouts have already completed their swim test.

First meal at camp will be dinner, Scouts should pack a light lunch and eat prior to or just after arrival at camp.

Break down campsite and pack gear by 9:00am

09:30am Brunch

10:30am Closing Ceremony

### Medication Notes

All medications (prescriptions and over the counter)

- Listed on a medical form and signed by scout's doctor
- In original prescription bottle or otc packaging
- If your scout has started on a medication after the health form was signed, please bring a doctor's signed note to camp.
- If a medication's instructions provide an option for time of day, (e.g. take once per day) parents should include a note with a recommended time.
- Place medications in plastic zip lock bag with Scout's name and Troop number.

**Trading Post** – Everyone enjoys a pause to refresh or pick up a few necessities. The average camper spends approximately \$40 per week while at summer camp for merit badge books, project kits and other essentials such as a T-shirt, hat, ice cream, candy and beverage.

### Family Brunch Saturday July 18th

A Family Brunch will be held from 9:30 – 10:15 AM on Saturday for parents and guests. Brunch tickets may be purchased during Check-In on Sunday or prior to arrival at camp. Ticket prices are: Adults --- \$8.00, Youths between 12 and 6 --- \$6.00. No charge for youths 5 and younger

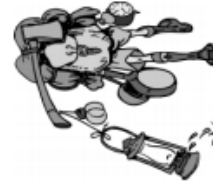

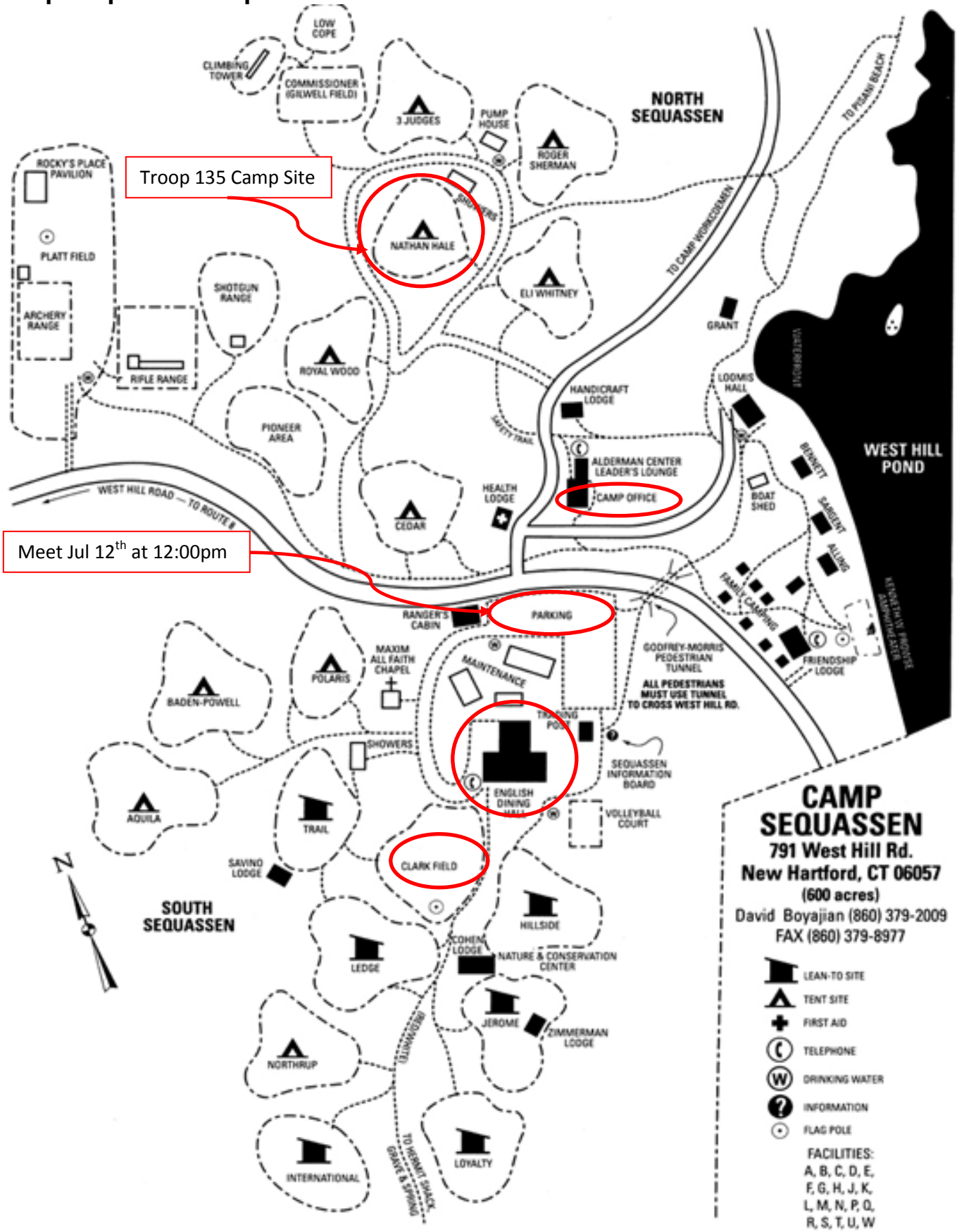

## Mosquito Net and Frame

One of the two ½" PVC Frames.  
Attach with duct tape to each end of bed



Rectangular Mosquito Net  
32" x 78" x 59"  
Available at most sporting goods stores



### Mosquito netting to sleep under

1/2 inch pvc frame needed (home depot or equivalent)

- 2 (29 inch long pieces)
- 4 (52 inch long pieces)
- 4 (90 degree elbows)
- netting and a little duct tape.
